

MRBS Varsity Girls' Soccer Pre-Season Information

To: Girls in Grades 7-12 and Parents

In a few weeks it will be time again for the spring season to begin. Please note the following information regarding the soccer season.

The first day for Varsity Soccer try-outs is Monday, February 27th. The team will practice from 3:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. Transportation will be provided there and back. All athletes may be picked up at the East Campus field by 5:45 p.m. Final rosters will be posted on Monday, March 5th.

For students to be eligible for try-outs the first day, they must turn in the following items at the first day of try-outs (students who do not turn in the following items will not be allowed to participate in try-outs). **Do not turn forms in before the first day of try-outs.**

1. **Sports Physical Examination from a Doctor (must be TAACS form!)**
2. **Sports Waiver**
3. **Information Sheet**
4. **Perforated Athletic Parent Voucher Permission Form turned in.**
5. **Fan Behavior Guideline Form**

*****Note: Those who have NOT participated in any sport this year should turn in all paperwork the first day of try-outs. Do NOT turn any paperwork into the office! Athletes who have participated in sports this year do not need to turn any paperwork.***

Uniforms:

The school will be providing uniform tops and shorts. All players will need black, white, or royal blue colored cleats (**NO NEON COLORS!**) and shin guards for soccer. Soccer players can also purchase socks from Mr. Leone for \$5.00 if they do not already have them (SOLID ROYAL).

All players will also have to purchase a practice uniform if they do not already have one. Short sleeve shirts are \$8.00 and the shorts are \$15.00. A long sleeve shirt (\$11.00) and a sweatshirt (\$12.00) may also be purchased as part of the practice uniform.

Eligibility:

All athletes must be passing all subjects and maintain a C average overall. For example, an athlete can have all A's, but if he has one F he will not be eligible to play. Also, if a student is passing all classes but has 3 C's and 3 D's he will not be eligible to play because he is not maintaining a C average overall. These are the Tennessee Association of Christian Schools' (TACS) eligibility policies. **All grade averages are cumulative from the first day of each semester.**

If a student is off for grades, he will still be required to attend practices and home games unless instructed differently by his coach. Ineligible players are not allowed to attend away games. Sometimes when an athlete is off for grades, he is required by the coach to not participate in practice. If an athlete is ineligible due to grades, he is still required to wear "game day" dress to school on game days since he is still part of the team. If the coach does not deem it necessary for an ineligible athlete to attend the game competition with the team, the athlete will not be allowed to attend the athletic function.

Game Season:

The game season will begin mid-March and end the last week of April. The varsity girls will play 5-7 games.

Practice Times:

Practice will be every day of the week except Wednesdays. Practices will be from 3:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. Transportation will be provided there and back whenever possible. Athletes being picked up at East must be picked up by 5:45 p.m.

Try-outs and Playing Time:

Please realize that the players exemplifying the best skills, attitude, and work ethic will be chosen for the team. Players chosen for the team will be given as much playing time as possible; however, these are competitive sports and **there is no guarantee to the amount of playing time each athlete will receive.**

Athletic Handbook:

Athletes are expected to abide by the policies in the Athletic Section of the Student Handbook.

Once you have committed to the team, you are expected to complete the season. Students who do not attend practice for any length of time for any excuse other than a medical excuse when present at school will be dismissed from the team. Athletes who do not compete in the final games of the season will be considered dismissed from the team.

Transportation

The athletic program would like to make it clear that most practices will be at the East Campus. Macon Road will provide transportation from the Berclair Campus to all after school practices. Students will need to be picked up at the East or Berclair Campus at the end of each practice or home game. Transportation may not be provided back to Berclair or East campus for some away games.

We look forward to a great soccer season. We appreciate your support and dedication to the MRBS athletic program.
